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

Justin's shirt and trousers (in the background) are from Hilton Weiner. **PREVIOUS SPREAD, LEFT** The courtyard leads into the kitchen through sliding doors that open wide. Leen and Peter's dog, Bo, who was rescued from an informal settlement in Somerset West, cools off on the snow-white cement floor that was painted with Nakkad. The extraction fan is from Kitchen Clinic and the blinds were made by Tailor Blinds. **FIRST SPREAD, LEFT** The old cellar had to make way for the new cement stairway that leads from the reception area to the suites. Suite 100 is in the background. **FIRST SPREAD, RIGHT** Two day beds were built above each other – the bottom one is for general use while the top one is for the exclusive use of guests in suite 300. But this wonderful resting space also serves another purpose: it is a retaining wall for the house. The cushions were specially made by Crazy Horse Trading.
